### Lesson Focus: Consistency

If we can have consistency, God can give us the eyes to see.

Eagle Mountain seeks to have consistency in doctrine and in how we approach God and others. Our faith pursuits are not about living from one emotional high to the next, but to be fully sanctified in Christ.

Consistency adds sustainability and health to our faith.

"Being led by the Spirit," means finishing what we started. Though God never changes, he is constantly changing us, refining us into his image.

It is important for us to be consistent and say YES to being transformed by God. Recognize that our journey of faith is part of the long game; that one day we will sit with Jesus on his throne. That is the reward that awaits us from living a life of faithful consistency.

*Revelation 3:21: To the one who is victorious (overcomes), I will give the right to sit with me on my throne, just as I was victorious and sat down with my Father on his throne.*

### Discussion on Consistency

1. Consistency defined: conformity in the application of something, typically that which is necessary for the sake of logic, accuracy, or fairness:
  - "the grading system is to be streamlined to ensure greater consistency"
  - Synonyms: evenness, steadiness, stability, constancy, regularity
  - **1 Corinthians 15:58** *Therefore, my beloved brothers, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that in the Lord your labor is not in vain.*
  - **Galatians 6:9** *And let us not grow weary of doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up.*
  - **James 1:4** *And let steadfastness have its full effect, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing.*
