How We Got NT Epistles/Letters

- •God spoke to and through Moses, then to Joshua, Samuel, Kings, & Prophets.
- •Their words match the words of Moses.
- Jesus clarifies the OT and taught the Disciples who became Apostles.
- Jesus now speaks (Heb. 1:1-4), as taught by the Apostles.
- Jesus made the 'mystery' known to the Apostles & they had authority others did not have.

How We Got NT Epistles/Letters

- Apostles spread the faith & plant and lead churches.
- Confront/correct false doctrine and write under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit.
- Their writings take Jesus' teachings and the words of Moses and the Prophets and address *issues*.
- •Some are specific (2 Thessalonians 1 3), and some are universal (Colossians 1:15-20).
- Much is used universally; kept in context.

Gospel	Comes	To	Crete

- •Likely-Jews visited Jerusalem to celebrate the Passover.
- At Pentecost the Gospel was heard, and some believed.
- •They went back to Crete and the faith spread.
- •With no formal leadership, issues would arise.
- Culture <u>negatively</u> <u>influenced</u> these early churches.
- Judaizers would also harass these early believers.
 - Said Jesus was ok, but you had to follow the Law.
 - Gentiles would have to be circumcised first.

Overview Of Titus

- Paul & Titus visited Crete in 61 AD. (Acts 27:8-9)
- Saw the issues firsthand; very pagan & crude culture.
- Polygamy, prevalent laziness, rebel-rousers, & lying.
- Paul departed but left Titus on Crete. (1:5)
- After Paul's departure, he wrote this letter to Titus.
- Titus was to establish Elders in every city (where house churches are located).
- This would provide leadership within the churches.
- *Disciple*, train, local members to equip and grow Elders.

Titus = Pastoral Epistles

- Pastoral Epistles (1 & 2 Timothy & Titus).
- Letters from a mature man near the close of his ministry.
- Concerned about/for his successors.
- Letters concern the things crucial for young pastors to know.
- Appointing leaders and church discipline.
- Opposition from rebellious members, dealing with false teachers, maintenance of doctrinal purity.
- Pastoral Epistles are the "how-to" manual for pastors (all church leaders) in all places and for all time.
