Small Group Study Questions

1. What did you find that was lost, that you were able to return to its owner? What did you lose and then was returned to you? In both situations, talk about what you felt, and how it might have changed the relationship with the person who lost something or returned something to you.
2. Can you share an example of trying to mix two things that did not go together? How did it work or turn out?
3. Talk about rules that are for our good, and those that teach us how to love each other better.
4. Verses 13-30 of this passage present rules around marriage and sex that may seem old-fashioned to our current time and culture. Discuss why you might feel this way. Do you see these rules as protecting both the institution of marriage as well as a woman who has to deal with a dishonest husband or man?
