## Questions for Discussion

- 3. What benefits does God offer those who turn their hearts to God in this Psalm (vs. 12-13)?
- 4. The psalm points to the way of relationship with God. How are we made right with God?

- 5. How does faithfulness sustain our spiritual lives like the crops that spring up from the ground?
- 6. Verse 12 speaks of increased yield. How do you know God has given you this increase? If God offers us peace through faithfulness and righteousness, how can you know the peace that surpasses understanding?
