TWO-PRONGED STRATEGY IN FACING ADAPTIVE CHALLENGE

A WIDE DOOR OF OPPORTUNITY

In this type of environment, the goal is to help people understand that the world is changing and that if they want to continue being faithful, they need to be open to new ways of thinking about their role in the world. For "traditional" churches that are strong and growing experimenting is about inviting them to use their existing strengths as a base to look toward God's future, instead of waiting until they hit a crisis. If strong churches develop a missional vision, they will be able to support new models of church and mission with their resources.
