### **Come to Jesus as a Child – (Mark 10:13-16)**

### **The Rich Young Ruler – (Mark 10:17-22)**

- Mark (10:17, 22) – Has possessions, has **wealth**
- Luke (18:18, 23) – A ruler and is very **wealthy**
- Matthew (19:16, 20) – Is young and has great **wealth**

### **The Question of What is Good? – (Mark 10:18-20)**

- Jesus is Good – 2 Corinthians 5:21, Hebrews 7:26, Mark 10:45
- *“...circumcised on the eighth day, of the people of Israel, of the tribe of Benjamin, a Hebrew of Hebrews; as to the law, a Pharisee; as to zeal, a persecutor of the church; as to righteousness under the law, blameless.”* - Philippians 3:5-6

- Luke 12:16-21 – The parable about a rich man who stored up his wealth.
