**SAUL** – Dangers of Slavery to Sin – *1 Samuel 20:25-34*

“... Saul’s anger was **kindled** against Jonathan, and he said to him . . .”

**DAVID** – Courage of a Godly Man – *1 Samuel 20:1-3*
