The Real Jesus

This passage is the end of the first section of the Gospel of Mark

Jesus is the Lord of the Sabbath (2:23-3:6)

Jesus is the promised Messiah (1:1-8)
Jesus is the Son of God (1:9-11)
Jesus is the king of a new kingdom he is creating through his disciples (1:12-15)
Jesus is the new authority (1:16-45)
Jesus is the Son of Man who forgives sin (2:1-12)
Jesus is the physician (2:13-17)
Jesus is the bridegroom (2:18-22)

Lord of the Sabbath – the climactic end of this section, the most incredible claim of Jesus yet

The Sabbath and the Bible

Sabbath is a creation pattern for rest from labor

"² And on the seventh day God finished his work that he had done, and he rested on the seventh day from all his work that he had done. ³ So God blessed the seventh day and made it holy, because on it God rested from all his work that he had done in creation." – Genesis 2:2-3

"Therefore the people of Israel shall keep the Sabbath, observing the Sabbath throughout their generations, as a covenant forever. ¹⁷ It is a sign forever between me and the people of Israel <u>that in six</u> <u>days the LORD made heaven and earth</u>, and on the seventh day he rested and was refreshed." – Exodus 31:16-17

Sabbath is a spiritual promise of ultimate rest

"8 do not harden your hearts, as at Meribah, as on the day at Massah in the wilderness, 9 when your fathers put me to the test and put me to the proof, though they had seen my work. ¹⁰ For forty years I loathed that generation and said, "They are a people who go astray in their heart, and they have not known my ways." ¹¹ Therefore I swore in my wrath, "They shall not enter my rest." – Psalm 95:8-11

"So then, there remains a Sabbath rest for the people of God, ¹⁰ for whoever has entered God's rest has also rested from his works as God did from his." – Hebrews 4:9-10 (quoting Psalm 95)
