

**Psalm 66:18**






## Matthew 6:9

God.






And on that day you will not




And whatever you ask in prayer,








He who did not spare His

A prayer of a righteous person, when it is brought about, can accomplish much.








And whenever you stand praying, **forgive**,

**Mark 11:25**








You ask and do not receive, because you ask with the **wrong motives**, so that you may spend *what you request* on your pleasures.

**8.** But the centurion replied, “Lord, I am not worthy for You to come under my roof, but just say the word, and my servant will be healed. **9.** For I also am a man under authority, with soldiers under me; and I say to this one, ‘Go!’ and he goes, and to another, ‘Come!’ and he comes, and to my slave, ‘Do this!’ and he does *it*.” **10.** Now when Jesus heard *this*, He was amazed and said to those who were following, “Truly I say to you, I have not found such great faith with anyone in Israel.

**11.** And I say to you that many will come from east and west, and recline *at the table* with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob in the kingdom of heaven; **12.** but the sons of the kingdom will be thrown out into the outer darkness; in that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.” **13.** And Jesus said to the centurion, “Go; it shall be done for you as you have believed.” And the servant was healed at that *very* moment.





# Four ways God Answers Prayers


1. YES
