Passage: Ezekiel 43: 1-11

Theme: God's Glory Restored

How God restores his glory:

1. God accomplishes all that is necessary to bring his people back into right relationship with himself (Ezek. 37:15–28).
2. God reestablishes the presence of his glory among his people (Ezek. 43:1–11; cf. John 1:14; 2:19-21).
3. God places his glory as a permanent dwelling in the midst of his faithful people (Ezek. 48:35; 1 Cor. 3:16–17; 6:19; Rev. 21:3, 21).

Main Idea: God restores his glory among a chosen people so that all might know who he is and what he has done.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

- List all the actions and results that God accomplishes for his people in Ezekiel 37:15–28. How do these provide you with assurance and confidence in God?
- What response does God expect from his people in regards to his work and reestablishment of his glory according to Ezek. 37:15–28 and 43:1–11? What should this look like in your life today?
- How does the NT identify the fulfillment of these promises by God to Ezekiel in the following passages: John 1:14–18; 2:18–22; 1 Cor. 3:16, 17; 6:19–20; Rev. 21:1–21)? From these texts, where is the glory of God dwelling today? How should this affect the way we live individually and what we do corporately?
