Title: A Burning Bush, An Old Shepherd, and the Holiness of God

Discussion Questions:

1. What is your general attitude/ posture toward God? Do you sense the reality of His holiness? In what ways is that reflected in your life?

2. Is there any situation in your life of which you feel like God is either unaware or unconcerned about? What does God's response to Israel's suffering reveal about His character?

Point of Passage:

Summary: This week we will continue our study of the book of Exodus by looking into the famous account of God calling Moses via a burning bush, Moses' reluctance to get on board, and God's gracious persistence to accomplish His purposes.

3. What areas of insecurity or weakness cause you to doubt God's ability to use you for His glory?
