10.22.17 Sermon: Return and Confrontation

Passage: Exodus 4:18–5:23 Series: "HOLY" Title: Return and Confrontation

Context: God calls Moses, but Moses questions God's plan and makes excuses not to do it

God vindicates himself and his plan (4:18–31) ® Learn the lesson the first time and believe.

God's plan and purposes will be opposed (5:1–14) $\ensuremath{\mathbb{R}}$ Be ready for opposition.

God's plan may be questioned by those whom he has called (5:15–23) ® Know that the unfolding of God's plan won't always make sense to you.

Point of the Passage: Trust and be encouraged that God's plan for life will come to fruition.

Discussion Questions:

In these incidents, how does God show that he was right from the beginning? How has God proven himself right from the beginning in your life?

Can you recall any incidents in your life where God confronted you in a powerful way with something that you were doing wrong?

How do we see God's plan and purposes being opposed today? On a global scale? In your own life?

Describe incidents where the unfolding of God's plan in your life didn't make sense. How did you/are you deal(ing) with that?
