2. Jesus' Credentials (16b)
 - a. He is God ("I am")
 - b. He is Messiah
3. Invitations to "Come" (17)
 - a. The Spirit and Bride say "Come"
 - b. Let the hearer say "Come"
 - c. Let the one in need come
 - d. Let the desirer take freely of the life-giving water

Main Idea: Jesus' Revelation invokes invitation.

2. What component (warning, encouragement, exhortation) of Jesus' Revelation has stood out to you most? Why?
3. Do you presently cry out for Jesus to come? If not, what is hindering you from doing so?
4. In what ways do we "come" to Jesus as believers? Do you come primarily out of need (17c) or desire (17d)? Explain.
