#### **LEVITICUS 5 - 7**

The sin offering continues on in chapter five until verse thirteen which gives to us various cases of sins or omission, four to be exact.

#### 5:1-4 The cases of sins of omission.

- 5:1 1) Failure to reveal truth regarding a matter or a witness to or oath before God.
  - A person can lie by distorting the truth, telling a story to cause a person to perceive them in a better light.

Or by mere silence not being truthful about themselves or a situation.

- **5:2 2)** Ceremonial uncleanness unconsciously by an animal.
- 5:3
  3) Ceremonial uncleanness unconsciously by man
  dead body, excrement, uncleanness of a woman or discharge of semen through sexual intercourse.
- **5:4 4)** Speaking rashly or thoughtlessly.

- <u>swear</u> (shelba) means to be completely to seven oneself by repeating a declaration seven times (Jephthah in Judges 11)
- <u>Deut.23:21</u> vows were not mandatory but if you made then you were compelled to keep them.

# <u>5:5-13</u> The procedure for forgiveness.

- 5:5 1) confess to say the same thing or agree regarding one's guilt.
- **5:6 2)** sacrifice a female hands laid, etc.
  - 3) at nement by the blood 17:11.
- **5:7 4)** Optional provision of two turtledoves or pigeons, one for sin the other for a burnt offering.
- <u>5:8-10</u> 5) The priests procedure.
- **5:11-136**) Poverty provision, 1/10 of a ephah with no oil or frankincense for it was for sin.

# 5:14-19 The trespass offering or reparation.

- 5:14 1) vs.15-16 regarding the holy things of the Lord unintentionally.
  2) vs.17-19 regarding the commandments of the Lord unintentionally.
- 5:15 Trespass breach of faith, act of treachery with the idea of invading the rights of others and property, here and 6:2, 26:40.
  - every trespass is a sin but not every sin is a trespass! (Dr. Kellogg) 5:6,7, 15b, 16, 18, 19 the root is to be guilty though translated "trespass".
  - The trespass offering is characterized by restoration and satisfaction Eph. 2:1.

## **5:16 2) Restitution** - 20%

**5:17-193**) Trespass against the commandments of the Lord unintentionally, he is still guilty.

- **6:1-2** \* it is a trespass against the Lord vs.2.
  - 1) Lying to neighbor regarding something left in safe keeping Ex.22:7-15, Num.5:5-10.
  - 2) Security of loans, a pledge.
  - 3) Robbery of goods.
  - **4)** Exhortation of wages or property as Nabothe's vineyard 1King 21.
- <u>6-3</u> 5) Lying about finding lost property.
- 6-4-5 Restitution and 20% in addition. Zachaeus Lk. 19:8-9.
- **6:6-7** Satisfaction for atonement.
