- -Beautiful love story between Ruth the Moabite and her mother-in-law Naomi and Boaz the Kinsman redeemer.
- -Picture of the future fulfillment when we will be wed to Christ (Redemption).
- -The author is unknown
- -The Tulmud attributes it to Samuel.
- -Written at time when they practiced plucking off shoe or losing shoe, <u>4:7</u>.
- -Kiel & Delitzsch believe the purpose of the book is given in 4:17-22 when the genealogy of David is given.
- -Making Ruth the Great grandmother of David in the lineage of the Messiah.
- -Matt. 1,.5 both Ruth and Rahab gentile are in genealogy of Christ, as well as Tamar, VS-3, who played the harlot, Gen. 38, VS-6 Bathsheba.
- -,book bears the heroin name, Ruth. Some declare it means "friend", others "beauty".
- -Hebrew canon is found 2nd in the third section of the writings, Canticle Ruth, Lamentations, Ecclesiastes, Esther.
- -Read at Pentecost because of wheat harvest connection.
- -But more than this, it gives to us a record of faithfulness to Jehovah in the midst of anarchy and degeneracy, <u>VS-1</u>, time of the judges.

- -Some believe perhaps around Ch. 6 when the Medianites ruled for 7 years and Gideon was threshing wheat at the winepress.
- -At the same time, it shows us of God's grace to receive even a Moabite who pledges her love to God by faith.
