Leviticus 21-23

Tonight we want to continue in our study of Leviticus and look at a number of regulations for the priests, eating sacred food and acceptable sacrifices and festival calendar.

21:1-15 The Law of mourning and marriage for the priest.

21:1-9 The regular priest.

- **21:1** Introductory formula to Moses for Aaron's sons.
- **21:2-4** exception for mourning for dead
- **<u>21:5-6</u>** pagan practices for mourning
 - 1) to be holy to their God
 - 2) Not to profane the name of their God
 - 3) they have the privilege of intercessors

<u>21:7-8</u> prohibitions for marriage

- 1) He is to be holy.
- 2) God is the one who sanctifies man.

21:9 Greater consequences to daughter of priest bringing defileness and shame.

21:10-15 The High Priest

- 21:10 The High Priest at Jesus' trial tore his garment.
- 21:11-12 He had a greater responsibility therefore called to stricter life 10:6-7.
- 21:13-15 He was to like only a virgin of Israel to insure that his posterity is not profaned.

21:16-24 The Law of physical qualifications for the priest.

- **21:16-17** The regulations are to approach God in service.
- **21:18-21** Various impediments and defects.
- 21:22-24 He could eat the bread due to him but not serve 1 Tim.3:1-13, 5:1, 17, Tit.1:5-9, 1 Pet.5:1-5.

<u>22:1-16</u> The law for eating sacred food.

- **22:1-2** Aaron and sons are addressed.
- <u>22:3-8</u> Ceremonial defilement of priest.
- **22:9** penalty of death
- **22:10** No stranger or hired servant.
- **22:11-13** exceptions
- 22:14-16 eating unintentionally demanded sacrifice and 20% added.

22:17-33 The law of offerings accepted.

- 22:17-25 Offering was to be of free-will and without blemish Mal.1:8, 13-14.
- 22:26-28 prohibition of sacrifice
- 22:29-30 Thanksgiving offering to be eaten the same night.
- 22:31-33 Reasons for obedience
 1) I am the Lord

- 2) I will be hollowed among the children of Israel.
- 3) I am the Lord who sanctifies you.
- **4)** Who brought you out of the land of Egypt.
- 5) I am the Lord.

23:1-44 The Feasts of the Lord.

- 23:1-2 The proclamation to observe the feasts of the Lord.
 appointed seasons vs.2(2 times), 4(2 times), 37.
- 23:3 The Sabbath Gen.2:1-3, Ex.20:11, Heb.4:1-3.
- 23:4-8 The Passover feast and unleaven bread.
- **23:4-5** April 14, <u>Ex.12</u> redemption, Jn.1:29.
- **23:6-8** April 15-21, <u>Ex.13</u>, 1 Cor.5:7-8.

23:9-14 The feast of Firstfruits

23:9-10 Spring harvest of barley

- **23:11-12** Offered on Sunday with burnt offering, prophetic of resurrection.
- 23:13 oil Holy Spirit sweet aroma-pleasing
- 23:14 prohibition
- 23:15-22 The feast of Weeks.
- **23:15-16** Summer harvest 50 days after Passover.
- 23:17 <u>two loaves</u> Jew and Gentile Act 2, 10, the Church.

 <u>leaven</u> church still has sin nature
- 23:18-21 sacrifices to be offered
- **<u>23:22</u>** provisions for the poor
- 23:23-25 The feast of Trumpets
- 23:23-24 Oct.1st, the holy month and end of agricultural year and beginning of civil year Neh.8:9-12.

23:26-32 The Day of Atonement

23:26-29 Oct 10th, day of sorrow and afflictions for natural sin.

23:30-32 statue forever

23:33-44 The feast of Tabernacles

 3 feast by law to observe,
 Passover, Pent, Tabernacle
 Ex.23:16-17, 34:22-23.
 * Jesus on the last day of feast
 Jn.7.

 * Only feast to be celebrated in Millennium Zach.14:16-17.
