LEVITICUS Chapters 13-15

Continuing in the 3rd division, we will be looking at the law of leprosy and bodily discharges, detection and ceremonial purity.

- There are four major divisions which are introduced by an introductory formula; the Lord speaking to Moses and Aaron or just Moses and a summary of the section <u>13:1-59, 14:1-32, 14:33-</u> <u>57 and 15:1-33</u>.

13:1-8 New Leprosy

- **<u>13:1-2</u>** Three cases on skin surface - Hansen's disease discovered -1871
 - 1) Elephantaisis
 - **a**) Nodular or tubercular
 - **b**) Anesthetic
 - 2) Skin disorders.
- **<u>13:3-4</u>** The priest was the only one to observe, detect and pronounce clean or unclean after 7 days.

- **<u>13:5-6</u>** Non progressive sore were observed another 7 days and if remained so, were clean.
- **<u>13:7-8</u>** If spread he was unclean.

<u>13:9-17</u> <u>Old Leprosy</u>

13:9-13 This kind ran it's course and was non infectious like the sinner who has repented and lives by the Holy Spirit.

13:14-17 reappearance of raw flesh

13:18-23 Boils on the skin

13:18-19 clean

13:20-23 unclean

13:24-28 Burns on the skin

<u>13:25</u> unclean

<u>13:28</u> clean

13:29-44 Sore on head or beard

<u>13:30</u> <u>leprosy</u> - (Neteg) not sara'at, to scratch away, scabies.

13:33-34 shave and wash purification

<u>13:40</u> loss of hair

13:45-46 The prescribed conduct of the leper

signs of mourning <u>10:6, 21:10</u>
 solitary life

13:47-59 The leprous garment

13:47-51 examination

13:52-58 various options

<u>13:59</u> summary

- **<u>14:1-2</u>** Provisions for the cleansing of the leper.
- 14:3-20 examination and ritual
 1) birds symbolic of Jesus death and resurrection much like the two goat on the Day of Atonement <u>ch.16, vs.4-7</u>.
 2) Washing and shaving first 7 days <u>vs.8-9</u>.
 3) 8th day various sacrifices and reconsecration as the High Priest <u>vs.10-20</u>.

14:21-31 provisions for the poor

<u>14:32</u> summary

15:1-18 Male discharge

15:1-3 Long term discharge from sexual organ perhaps venereal disease.
- discharge (zôb) to flow
- runs (râr) used only here and connected with the word for saliva Job 6:6, 1 Sam.21:13.

15:4-12 ceremonial defilement

15:13-15 cleansing and sacrifice

15:16-17 nocturnal emissions

<u>15:18</u> sexual intercourse <u>15:19-30 Female discharge</u>

15:19:23 Woman's menstrual cycle separates her for a week out of the month and all who touched her were unclean.

<u>15:24</u> If she began her cycle while engaged in intercourse with her husband, he would be unclean 7 days.

- Willful intercourse during her cycle was punishable by death 18:19, 20:18, Ezk.18:6, 22:10.

15:25-27 Long term menstruation

* <u>Mk.5:25, Lk.8:43</u> woman with the issue of blood for 12 years. - No family life, sanctuary or social.

15:28-30 her cleansing right and sacrifice

- **<u>15:31</u>** Worship must be holy and pure.
- <u>**15:32</u>** Summary of law.</u>
