Have you had any opportunity to share the good news about Jesus (aka the Gospel)? Where & With Who?

Once again (see Acts 1), we see Peter taking a stand as the leader of the apostles. As you have grown in your relationship with Christ, do you have more confidence about the things of Christ? Does that translate into being more confident as a Christian to the world around you?

vs. 23 - According to this verse, Jesus' death was planned by God. What does this mean about who God is?

What kind of confidence does the resurrection give you about the promises of God?

Summarize what we learn about Jesus through these verses. Is there anything that Peter left out that he should have included?

Evangelism - that is a loaded word, but the basic meaning is that we are to tell others about Jesus. Would you be able to do that? How is your confidence in the knowledge about Jesus? If you say you are confident, will you pray for an opportunity this week to share with someone? If you are not confident, how can you get more confident? Discuss this with your group and end with prayer.
