

Small Group Study Questions Week 4

Zechariah 6:9-15 (NASB)

9 The word of the Lord also came to me, saying, 10 "Take an offering from the exiles, from Heldai, Tobijah, and Jedaiah; and you shall go the same day and enter the house of Josiah the son of Zephaniah, where they have arrived from Babylon.

11 Also take silver and gold, make an ornate crown, and set it on the head of Joshua the son of Jehozadak, the high priest. 12 Then say to him, 'The Lord of armies says this: "Behold, there is a Man whose name is Branch, for He will branch out from where He is; and He will build the temple of the Lord. 13 Yes, it is He who will build the temple of the Lord, and He who will bear the majesty and sit and rule on His throne. So He will be a priest on His throne, and the counsel of peace will be between the two offices." 14 Now the crown will become a reminder in the temple of the Lord to Helem, Tobijah, Jedaiah, and Hen the son of Zephaniah. 15 Those who are far away will come and build the temple of the Lord." Then you will know that the Lord of armies has sent me to you. And it will take place if you completely obey the Lord your God.

How is Jesus our king? (Read Revelation 19:11-19 for further information)

Read Zechariah 6:14-15 Why do we need reminders about who wears the crown?

Jesus is our High Priest and King. What difference does that or should it make in your life?
