## Redemption, Propitiation, Reconciliation

**Rom. 5:8** But God **demonstrates** His own **love** toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, **Christ died for us.** 

**Rom. 3:24** Being justified as a gift by His grace **through the redemption** which is in Christ Jesus;

Heb. 2:14 Because God's children are human beings—made of flesh and blood—the Son also became flesh and blood. For only as a human being could he die, and only by dying could he break the power of the devil, who had the power of death.

Heb. 2:15 Only in this way could he set free all who have lived their lives as slaves to the fear of dying.

1. Redemption: The death of Jesus \_\_\_\_\_\_ from the control of sin, death, evil powers, fears, religious performance and so much more!

Rom. 3:25 whom God displayed publicly as a propitiation in His blood through faith. This was to demonstrate His righteousness...

Greek word order: ...whom God displayed publicly a place of propitiation/Mercy Seat [= Gk.

hilasterion] through faith by His blood...

2. Propitiation: The death of Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ of God over

1John 2:2 and He Himself is **the propitiation [sin-offering, Gk. hilasmos] for our sins**; and not for ours only, but also for those of the whole world.

Rom. 5:10 For if while we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life.

3. Reconciliation: The death of Jesus removes \_\_\_\_\_\_ between you and God.

2Cor. 5:18 Now all these things are from God, **who reconciled us to Himself through Christ** and gave us the ministry of reconciliation,

2Cor. 5:19 namely, that **God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself,** not counting their trespasses against them, and He has committed to us the word of reconciliation.

Rom. 5:1 ... We have **peace with God** through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Big Idea: You can find all you need to have \_\_\_\_\_ with God at the cross of Jesus.
