Unstoppable Week 4: God's Grace

Acts 27:1-3, Acts 27:9-12, Acts 27:18-20, Acts 27:21-26, Acts 27:30-37, Acts 27:42-44

Have you ever experienced a travel plan going completely wrong? How did you respond, and what did you learn?

Read Acts 27:14-32

What natural events caused the ship's journey to become dangerous (vv. 14–20)? At what point would you have given up and stopped trying to move forward?

Critique Paul's message: from a non-believing sailor's or soldier's point of view, did it give hope?

Paul told the people to "keep up your courage" (v. 22). What helps you stay courageous when you're in a difficult situation?

How would you categorize verse 26? Is it prophecy, prediction, or just a natural consequence of their actions?

Read Acts 27:33-44

How does Paul's faith in God's message contrast with the fear and actions of the sailors and soldiers?

List the ways that Paul's example or encouragement changed the situation for those on the ship.

Why did the centurion choose to spare Paul's life instead of following the plan to kill the prisoners?

When facing storms in life—literal or metaphorical—how can we trust in God's promises like Paul did?

What is one takeaway from these verses for you?
