Colossians 3:1-2

Therefore, if you have been raised with Christ, keep seeking the things *that are* above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. 2 Set your minds on the things *that are* above, not on the things that are on earth.

Colossians 3:9-10

Do not lie to one another, since you stripped off the old self with its *evil* practices, 10 and have put on the new *self*, which is being renewed to a true knowledge according to the image of the One who created it—

Colossians 3:17

Whatever you do in word or deed, *do* everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks through Him to God the Father.

Colossians 3:18-19

Wives, be subject to your husbands, as is fitting in the Lord. 19 Husbands, love your wives and do not become bitter against them.
