Connect: What is the next right thing for you this week? Where have you seen God in hard places?

Engage: Re Read Ruth 2:1- 23. What stands out to you this time you read it?

Advent love – God gives us a home. Where have you found home this Advent season.

Ruth 2:1 – Where have you experienced God turning your bitterness into hope?

Kindness is throughout scripture. Are there any verses you can bring to memory that talk about Kindness?

Hesed shel Emet- steadfast love, someone who is so good, selfless, loving, merciful, and kind that they will go out of their way to work extravagantly, crossing barriers on someone's behalf. Besides Jesus can you think of someone who has shown you Hesed?

This story of Ruth is also the story of God. God was the redeemer for us.

Naomi was also in a place of waiting. Are you in a place of waiting this Christmas season?

Zach shared 4 points with us.

1. God who sees.
2. God who shelters
3. God who serves
4. God who provides

Which one of these is the most important to you right now? Why is that so significant to you?

Apply: What is the invitation for you this week? Where do you need to press into God's love, this Christmas season? Where do you need to express love this week to someone who needs it?
