Genesis 3:15, Exodus 5-12:12,15:11-13 Romans 1:21-24,
Ephesians 4:17-19

Connect: Can you relate to Moses, when God called you to do something and you were not sure how God was going to come through? What happened?

Engage: Hopefully you have read through the chapters in Exodus 5-12

What stirs in you with the statement in Exodus 15:3

“The Lord is a warrior; the Lord is His name” God will rescue His people He is not okay with staying stuck. What do you think of that statement?

Through all the plagues Pharaoh’s heart became hard. More resolved as he continued to oppose God’s people. Which plague seems worse to you as you think about them? Nile to blood, frogs, lice, flies, livestock, boils, hail, fire, locust, pests, darkness and death of the first-born.

How does your heart respond to God’s authority? Do you harden your heart towards God’s authority? Romans 1:21-24,

We want what we want. How does that show up in your life, Do you give God part of your life but not all?

God is calling His people back, but we refuse. So, Israel complains even as life gets harder, but they stay stuck.

We underestimate God in 2 areas.

1. The seriousness of sin
2. The greatness of God

Which one of these do you wrestle with? Do you defend sin in your life or do you struggle with the greatness of God?

The plague of death of first born – blood was needed – Communion/ shed blood. -
Passover begins the re-creation of His people. How does that make you feel?

Patterns of Redemption

1. God hears our groaning. Where are you groaning to God?
2. God exposes slavery. Where have you been enslaved by sin? Where do you need to name that before the Lord?
3. God sends a savior? – Where do you need Jesus right now?
4. God leads us into dependence. Where do you need to depend on God?

Apply: Who are you serving, Yourself or God? Do you truly have a soft heart for God? What idols are a part of my life? What is the invitation for you this week?
