Connect: When did you understand the importance of communion? What was that like for you?

Engage: Reread Exodus 12-15

Zach talked about the DNA of the Christian faith would be the Passover and the passage through the Red Sea. Have you ever thought of that was the precursor of Christ's sacrifice on the cross?

Everyone needs a rescue. Where have you needed rescue from Jesus?

All through the Old Testament God rescued his people. What story comes to mind for you in the Old Testament where you remember God rescuing His people?

Substitutionary Atonement –A Christian theological doctrine stating that Jesus Christ died on the cross as a substitute for humanity, paying the penalty for human sin to satisfy God's justice and reconcile humanity with God. Primarily held in evangelical Protestantism, it is often termed "penal substitution," asserting that Christ took the punishment (wrath) that sinners deserved. These verses are a foreshadowing of Christ -Genesis 3:21, Abraham and Isaac, and Passover in all of these stories - God sends a substitution. Which one of these has the most impact for you as you read them?

Zach shared with Communion - that we cannot experience freedom with death

Where have you experienced freedom?

Is there a situation where do you need to forgive as Christ forgave or a resentment or a pride?

2. We need to trust God

Where do you need to trust the blood of the Lamb this week for your sin?

Are you willing to trust God to set you free from your past?
