Psalm 95, Exodus 17

Connect: What is your favorite way to worship God? How did you experience worship growing up?

Engage: Reread Psalm 95

What stands out to you as you read this Psalm?

Pastor Zach talked about 4 movements

1. The invitation to joyful awe
 - A. The invitation come to behold
 2. How worship brings us to our Shepherd
 4. How worship invites us to come and rest
1. The invitation to joyful awe.
 - A. Where have you seen something beautiful this summer?
 - B. How did you feel seeing that? Where have you shared that with someone?
 - C. Have you ever been captured by beauty? Has that caused you to praise God or did you just take it for granted?
2. The invitation to behold vs. 3-5
 - A. gadol –(great) large (in magnitude and extent). In number, in intensity loud (in sound) older (in age) in importance. Do you see God that way or has he become common place in your life? Does your heart sing praise that the God of the universe wants to know you? Are you shaken by who God is?
 - B. Worship – worth – shape. Does God evoke worship in you? How do you express value to the Lord?
 - C. What are the ways in which we as God's people worship Him?
 - D. What we consider worthy captures our attention and actively shapes our character, desires and lives. What does that look like for you?
3. How worship brings us to the Shepherd? Vs. 6-7
 - A. About surrender – Where do you need to surrender to the Shepherd?
 - B. You are God and I am not. - Do you see the right relationship with God or do you try to be God in some areas of your life?
 - C. Why do I lie? Why am I unable to rest? Why does criticism devastate me? Why do I need to control everyone around me? What do I value? Which one of these questions do you resonate with the most? What do you think God is initiating you do with that question you struggle with?
4. Worship invites us to come and rest.
 - A. In worship we understand our value. How does that sit with you?
 - B. What have I been giving too much worth to in my life?
 - C. Where have I been striving? Where is your focus?

Apply: What is the invitation for you this week? Where has your heart become hard?

What burden are you carrying that the Lord is asking you to put down? Where have you taken the Lord for granted ?
