Salvation:

- 1. Jesus was obedient to God's law active in pursuing what God had called Him to do?
- 2. Submissive He receives punishment on our behalf.
- 3. Passive passio to receive and endure. How do you receive and endure things that are hard?

Zach went back to Genesis

Adam spoke and pointed a finger when he should have been quiet and listened.

He was quiet and passive when He should have spoken up and pointed His finger.

King Ahab resisted the Father and submitted to evil

Enemy comes in and says God is lying to you. Where do you believe the enemy and act on it?

King Jesus resisted against evil and submitted to the Father. Where have you resisted evil and submitted to Jesus?

Where do you struggle?

All addictive behavior is due to what we cannot control.

Things we cannot control:

God's law, Circumstances, your friend, the weather, the past, the future
