Connect: How have you experienced community? What has been your experience of dancing? What do you think of the statement Zach made Relationships /Friendships can change the world?

Engage: Reread John 17 Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal anything that the Trinity would want you to hear.

What is your understanding of the Trinity? What do you think of the thought that they do a dance with each other? What do you think of the Trinity submitting to each other.

Zach talked about the Trinity lifting each other up through 3 movements

- 1. The beginning Glory
- 2. The present Glory
- 3. The present Future

1.The beginning Glory

- a. God from the beginning has been 3 persons.
- b. The Holy Spirit is giving glory to Jesus, Jesus giving glory to the Father
- c. Creation was brought about through the Trinity- Genesis 1 Where do you see the Trinity in this chapter?
- d. Zach talked about the 3 different thoughts Ancient, Modern and Eastern
- e. Love is primary as the foundation of reality which is contrary to the world.
- f. Can you bask in the fact that we are the product of the Love relationship of the Godhead.
- g. Do you often find yourself wanting to get something from someone or something that only God can give?
- 2. The Present Glory
- a. Through my death would you bring Glory to us where it was in heaven?
- b. Can you empty yourself to serve others? Where are you selfish?

Serving someone often means not confronting them or confronting them. What is the most loving? Can you trust the Holy Spirit to lead you?

- c. Can you submit to the Trinity and to others out of knowing that God is so delighted with you?
 - 3. Future Glory

Vs. 3 Where do you need to self-sacrifice for the glory of God? Help us to see the world through Your eyes. Can you ask God to give you His eyes to see the world through the Trinity?
