

Read Hebrews 4:14-16, Eph 1:20-23

Q-Tell a time when you were really surprised by something either good or bad?

Q-Tell of a time when you faced something that was much harder than you expected? Did you quit? How did you make it through the hard circumstances? Looking back on the hard circumstances, how did God use this in your development?

Q-What element of the Jesus journey downward or upward is most intriguing to you? Why?

Q-Scripture teaches that Jesus, after His baptism, was led out into the wilderness by the Holy Spirit to face the devil. Why did Jesus have to go through this Judean Wilderness testing and the temptations of the devil?

Q-How does this help you in your prayer life to know that Jesus is a sympathizing Savior?

Q-What does it mean to come boldly to God's throne of grace? How did that differ from OT priests presenting themselves in God's holy presence?

Q-Pastor Tom said that God's grace is a throne of grace because He gives both resistance grace and renewing grace? What does he mean by those terms? Q-How often do you go to the throne of grace when faced with temptation?

Q-Why is it important to go to the throne of Grace in asking prayer the moment we feel temptation creeping in on us?

Q-Even after we fall and even after falling many times into sin, what does it mean that the throne of grace is still a throne of grace? Is God's grace ever limited to a confessing sinner?
