Read Nehemiah 9:6; Psalm 8:4-6, 148:2,5-6; 1 Corinthians 6:3; Colossians 1:16

1. Where do angels come from? Why is this important?

2. If angels were created, like we are, what do you think our relationship with angels looks like? Why?

3. Three forms of angels described in the Bible are cherubim, seraphim and living creatures.

Read Genesis 3:24; Exodus 25:18-20; Hebrews 9:5; Isaiah 6:1-7; Ezekiel 1:5-14; Revelation 4:6-8.

4. How would you describe the cherubim?
5. How would you describe the seraphim?
6. How would you describe the living creatures?

Angels often were seen in human form as well.

Read Genesis 18:2,16; Ezekiel 9:2; Matthew 28:5; Hebrews 13:2

7. Why do you think that angels have appeared in human form?
8. Do you think that we still today “entertain angels”? Why or Why not?
