

The Gospel of Luke: Meeting Our Savior

Warm-Up Question:

If you grew up religious, what were some spoken or unspoken expectations on your behavior that were <u>not</u> necessarily from the Bible?

READ: Luke 5:33-39

I. NEW WINE AND NEW WINESKINS: DESIRE

- How does Jesus relate the "old wine" and "old wineskins" to a distortion of the gospel? (See v. 30-32 for context)
- Why is simply being religious and rule-keeping often seen as more appealing than receiving the gift of the gospel and surrendering your life to Christ?

II. NEW WINE AND NEW WINESKINS: PATCHWORK

- ▶ How does one's life look different believing these different views in the heart:
 - 1) Jesus + other loves/priorities in life = Salvation/relationship with God
 - 2) Jesus + my obedience = Salvation/relationship with God
 - 3) Jesus (alone) = Salvation/relationship w/ God...+ things in life & obedience
- Do you find it easy to fall back into the "old wine/wineskins" religious paradigm of relating with God (trying to prove yourself or earn what he gives for free)?

III. NEW WINE AND NEW WINESKINS: JOY

- What was the point of v. 34? Who is the bridegroom, and what does that say about him & us? How is Jesus pointing his disciples/us to live in light of the metaphor?
- The "bridegroom" was "taken away" to be put on a cross. How should that event forever change how we relate with God? How does fasting fit in now?
- Do you feel appropriate joy in God and in life because of your belief in the gospel? If not, what do you think is holding you back from experiencing it?

What is one main take-away you want to apply in your life this week?
