This guide is meant to equip you with discussion questions and conversation starters that you can use throughout the week to continue the conversation about what you and your kids learned on Sunday.

Sermon Summary

In case you missed it, or if you just need a refresher, here's a quick summary of what we talked about this week in the sermon:

This week's sermon, titled "Loving Enough to Serve," focused on the example of Jesus washing the disciples' feet, demonstrating ultimate humility and love. The sermon highlighted why the disciples served Jesus and contrasted it with why Jesus served them—out of love. The speaker

shared their personal journey of serving Jesus, emphasizing that love should be the motive for service, not titles or power. The message also underscored the importance of humility, reminding us to follow Jesus' example by serving others and understanding our limitations. Finally, we were challenged to adopt a mindset of serving others as Jesus served us, emptying Himself for our sake and calling us to do the same.

Conversation Starters

These are things you can talk about with your kids to help further the conversation about what they may have learned on Sunday.

- Discussing Service
 - What do you think it means to serve others out of love?
 - This question is derived from the section where the speaker talks about the motive of love behind Jesus' service to His disciples.
- Understanding Humility
 - Can you think of a time when you did something nice for someone without expecting anything in return?
 - This discussion starter stems from the part of the sermon where humility and serving in the shadows are emphasized.
- Role of Jesus as Teacher and Lord
 - Why do you think Jesus washed the disciples' feet even though He was their Lord?
 - This question is based on Jesus' example of humility and service outlined in the sermon.
- Personal Acts of Service
 - What is one thing you can do this week to show love to someone through service?
 - This relates to applying the sermon's teachings about serving others out of love in our daily lives.
- Learning from Others
 - Who is someone you look up to when it comes to serving others, and what have you learned from them?
 - This question touches on the importance of recognizing our limitations and being open to learning from others, as mentioned in the sermon.
