# RESOURCES FOR ADVENT

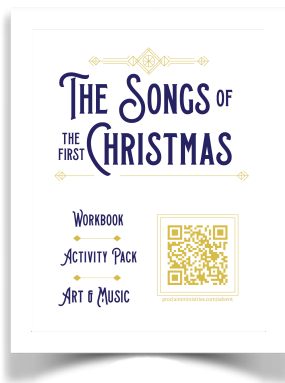

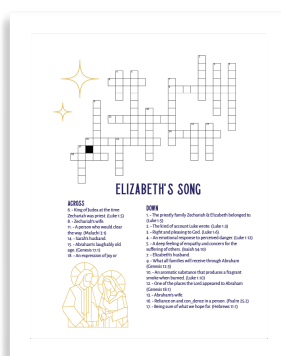
### Interactive Workbook:
