- 1. In Acts 6:8-15, Stephen is mischaracterized and slandered. Have you ever been falsely accused? How are you tempted to avoid this form of persecution?
- 2. In Acts 7, Stephen responds to false accusations by faithfully proclaiming Scripture. How does that help us know how to respond to push-back from the world? What steps can you take to grow in your knowledge of Biblical truth?
- 3. In Acts 7:54-60, what gives Stephen the courage to risk his life for Christ? How does that vision transform Stephen in his last moments?
- 4. In Acts 6:8-8:3, how can you see God accomplishing his purposes even through persecution? How does this give you hope that God is working through the opposition you face?
