1. A call that He alone is worthy of our love and obedience (6-11)

2. A call that He alone is worthy of our allegiance (vs 12-13)

III. A call to remember all that the Lord has <u>promised</u> (vs 14-16)

- 1. A call to remember He has not failed (vs 14)
- 2. A call to remember He can be trusted (vs 15-16)
