LET’S GO DEEPER:

1. This story begins and ends with Paul's partners (1-5 and 18-28). Who are Paul’s partners in ministry in Acts 18? In what ways do they support him? How do can we partner together to promote the ministry of the word?
2. Read Ezekiel 33:1-9. Why does Paul reference this passage in Acts 18:6?
3. In verses 9-10, what reasons does Jesus give Paul to endure in ministry? Which of these reasons encourage you to endure in the work God has called you to?
4. Why did Luke include the story of Paul’s trial before Gallio in verses 12-17? [Hint: It comes right after verses 9-11...]
