I. What is the difference? (vs 10-14)

1. Priest's work was never finished. (vs 11)
Phil 2:6-9
2. Priest's made the same sacrifices. (vs 11-12)
I Peter 3:18
3. Priest's sacrifice never took away sin. (vs 12b-13)
Ephesians 1:7
4. Priest's sacrifices never perfected man. (vs 14)
Galatians 1:4; I Peter 2:24

II. Who makes the difference? (vs 15-18)

Jeremiah 31:33-34

1. The Holy Spirit empowers the believer. (vs 15-16)
Ephesians 4:24; Romans 8:6
2. The Holy Spirit reveals godliness to the believer. (vs 16)
Philippians 3:10
3. The Holy Spirit gives the assurance of forgiveness to the believer. (vs 17)
Romans 8:15-17
4. The Holy Spirit reveals the finality of sacrifices to the believer. (vs 18)
I Corinthians 1:21-22
5. The Holy Spirit gives assurance of salvation to the believer. (vs 18)
John 14:16-17; I John 4:13
