- V. David disregarded God and served himself. 2 Samuel 11:4
- VI. David <u>compounded</u> the sin and <u>tried to cover it up</u>. 2 Samuel 11:6-17
- VII. David <u>confessed</u> his sin and <u>repented</u>.
