LET’S GO DEEPER:

1. Exodus 2:24 talks about one covenant which God made with Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, rather than three covenants. What does this tell us about the unity of God’s purpose in the Bible?
2. God’s covenant with the patriarchs is further mentioned in Exodus 32:13 and 33:1. What additional information is conveyed in these passages?
3. Read Matthew 26:17–29. Jesus wants to keep the Passover, but he inaugurates a new rite, which we call the Lord’s Supper. What are the similarities between Passover and Lord’s Supper? What are the differences? What does this passage tell us about the continuity between the Old and New Testaments?
