- **Definition of Kingdom Alignment**
- Aligning oneself with God's will, purpose, and ordained relationships for spiritual growth and effectiveness.
- The role of alignment, obedience, and unity in advancing the Kingdom.

I. The Call to Alignment

(1 Kings 19:19-21)

- **Elijah and Elisha: A Divine Connection**

- The symbolism of Elijah's cloak: A transfer of authority and responsibility.
- Elisha's response: Immediate obedience and sacrifice.

- The double portion: A reward of faithfulness and alignment.
- **Key Points:**
- Alignment requires persistence, faith, and the willingness to endure challenges.
- The reward of alignment is greater capacity for Kingdom work.

III. The Unity of Alignment

(Psalm 133)

- **The Beauty and Power of Unity**
- The imagery of oil: Anointing flows from the head (leadership) to the body.
- The dew of Hermon: Refreshing and life-giving blessings that come through unity.
- Promise: Where there is unity, God commands His blessing.
- **Key Points:**
- Alignment creates an atmosphere for the anointing to flow unhindered.
- The importance of submitting to spiritual authority to experience divine blessings.

IV. Spiritual Fatherhood and Alignment

(1 Corinthians 4:14-16)

- **Paul as a Spiritual Father**
- The role of spiritual leaders in guiding, correcting, and nurturing believers.
- "Imitate me": The call to align with godly examples in life and ministry.
- The responsibility of spiritual children to honor and follow their leaders.
- **Key Points:**
- Alignment fosters mentorship and spiritual growth.
- God places spiritual leaders in our lives to provide direction and accountability.

V. The Blessings of Kingdom Alignment

- **Provision and Anointing**
- Alignment unlocks divine resources and spiritual empowerment.
- **Authority and Impact**
- Walking in alignment positions us to operate in greater authority and effectiveness in the

Kingdom.

- **Unity and Peace**
- Alignment fosters harmony and the commanded blessings of God.
