 - B. The compassion of Jesus (v. 9:35-36)
- II. Compassion received
 - A. Received by grace alone (v. 9:37-10:10)
 - B. Delivering what you receive
- III. Compassion uncompromised
 - A. Compassion and judgment (v. 10:11-15)
 - B. Word and deed (v. 9:35, 10:7-8)
