How does Jesus' resurrection rewrite the story of your life?

- I. The story of your sin
 - A. The healing of Mary Magdalene (v. 1, 10; Luke 8:2)
 - B. The power of Jesus' resurrection (v. 2-3; 1 Cor. 15:17; 2 Cor. 5:17)
- II. The story of your trust
 - A. The doubt of the women (v. 4-5a)
 - B. Trusting Jesus' words (v. 5b-9; Jas. 1:2-4; John 15:20; Matt. 10:29-31)
- III. The story of your future
 - A. The skepticism of the disciples (v. 11)
 - B. Skepticism to belief (v. 12; John 20:6-8)
 - C. A glorious future (v. 12; Phil. 3:20-21)

Application Guide:

1. In what ways does sin and/or evil torment you? How do you feel trapped by it? Why is it so important to understand sin as an enslaving power and not just a set of bad decisions or poor choices?
2. In your current situation, what words are you prone to trust other than Jesus'? Why does it seem so difficult at times to trust Jesus' word?
3. How does the bodily resurrection of Jesus give you hope for your future? How does this future hope impact the way you live today?
