Why does Christ's resurrection produce indestructible joy?

- I. New record
 - A. Righteousness secured by Jesus (v. 1)
 - B. The resurrection receipt (Rom. 10:9b-10a)
- II. New identity
 - A. Receiving or making a name (v. 2-3; Gen. 11:4)
 - B. The result of identity
- III. Restored dignity
 - A. Abandoned and ruined (v. 4a)
 - B. Object of God's delight (v. 4b-5)

Application Guide:

- 1. Are you ridden with guilt and shame over your past? How does the new record given to you by Jesus produce joy?
- 2. In what ways are you attempting to make a name for yourself? How is this producing anxiety? How have you experienced the joy of receiving your identity from Christ?
- 3. How has God's delight in the face of Christ washed away feelings of unworthiness? Are you experiencing God's delight over you?
