 - A. Eternal life (v. 11-14; John 17:3; 2 Tim. 4:6-7)
 - B. Take hold (v. 12)
- III. A contentment seized through generosity
 - A. The command to give (v. 18)
 - B. The result of generosity (v. 19; Matt. 25:40)
