

Revival When God Seems Silent **Isaiah 64:1-12**

What brings revival when God seems silent?

- I. Confession of sin
 - A. The heart of sin (63:17; 64:5b, 6-7a)
 - B. Conviction and confession of sin
- II. Confession of God's character
 - A. Aspects of God's character (64:8; Rom. 9:21; Luke 12:6-7)
 - B. The need for God's character
- III. Confession of faith
 - A. God comes down (63:15b; 64:1-3; Matt. 9:36)
 - B. Response to God coming down (64:4)
 - C. The eye of faith (John 16:13-14; Heb. 11:26-27)

Application Guide:

1. Do you confess your sin before God in an honest, transparent, and vulnerable way? Why or why not?
2. Are you confessing God's character - his love, sovereignty, and care – in the midst of your sin and/or chaos? Why do you need God's character more than his action?
3. Have you experienced the Holy Spirit making Jesus Christ a living, bright reality to you? What were the circumstances surrounding this?
