Discussion Questions:

- Why is it important to be connected to Jesus in order to bear fruit in our lives? What does it mean to "abide" in Jesus, and how can we cultivate this connection in our daily lives?
- In what ways have you experienced God's pruning in your life, and how did it help you bear more fruit? How can we learn to see the pain of pruning as necessary and beneficial for our spiritual growth?
- What does it mean to be fruitful in character and fruitful for the kingdom, and how can we actively pursue these two types of fruit in our lives?
- How can we encourage and support one another as we seek to grow in our character and fruitfulness, both individually and as a community? What practical steps can we take to cultivate growth in these areas?
