Discussion Questions:

- What stood out to you from the sermon on Sunday?
- John's Gospel begins much differently than the other Gospel accounts. Why is it important and valuable to see that the story of Jesus actually begins before creation?
- **Read John 1:1-5.** List the attributes and activities of the Word contained in these verses.
- Does it make any difference to you to know that Jesus is eternal, God, and with us? How is this claim completely unique and wonderful news?
- If Jesus is God, what is the appropriate response? For those who already follow Jesus, what does this look like in practical terms day-to-day?
- How should the reality of Jesus as our Creator impact our lives?
- **Read John 1:10-13.** Describe in your own words A) the bad news, and B) the good news.
- **Read John 1:14-18.** How would someone full of grace and truth treat others?
- According to verse 18, how can we be sure what God is like?
- How in life can we (sometimes) foolishly make trivial and insignificant things big, whilst relegating the most important reality of Jesus Christ as small? How can we strive to have a bigger view of Jesus?
