



Jesus Is Chief Servant- John 13

In this passage, Jesus demonstrates the importance of serving others through his act of washing his disciples' feet. He teaches that true greatness comes from serving others, and that his followers should follow his example by humbly serving one another.

Discussion Questions:

- What parts of this message do you feel like you really needed to hear?
- How does Jesus' love for his disciples and for us, as described in John 13:1, inspire you to love others?
- What is the significance of Jesus washing his disciples' feet in John 13:3-17? How does this act exemplify Jesus' heart of love and humility, and what does it teach us about being a disciple of Jesus?
- What is the importance of doing the lowly and undesirable tasks that no one else wants to do, as modeled by Jesus in washing his disciples' feet? How can we apply this principle in our daily lives, and what are some examples of how we can serve others and the church in practical ways?
- Why do you think Jesus chose to perform this act of service in a private room with just his disciples, rather than in public or for the sake of gaining recognition? What does this teach us about the nature of true service and humility?
