



Jesus Is The Light Of The World: John 8

In this week's message we examined Jesus great claim to be the Light of the World and why that is such good news.

Discussion Questions:

- What parts of this message do you feel like you really needed to hear?
- Jesus as the Light came to lead us not to accommodate our preferences, wishes, and desires. Why is that good news? What are some examples of things Jesus leads us to do that might be contrary to our natural, fallen inclinations?
- Jesus as the Light came to save us not to condemn us (John 3:17). In what ways does the story of the woman caught in adultery (7:53-8:11) illustrate the truth that it is the "kindness of God which leads to repentance" (Romans 2:4).
- Jesus as the Light came to free us from our sin not to affirm us in our sin (John 8:31-36). How can we love people well while at the same time not affirming sin in their lives? In what ways does Jesus present us with the perfect example of this?
- Jesus said that those who follow him would not walk in darkness but have the light of life (8:12). Take a look at Ephesians 5:6-14 and describe in your own words what it looks like for us to walk as children of light.
