



Renewed Part 2: One Body In Christ-Romans 12:3-8

In this passage, the Apostle Paul teaches that everyone should humbly use their unique gifts and talents to serve God and others, without thinking of themselves more highly than they ought to. The passage emphasizes the importance of working together as one body in Christ, with each person contributing their strengths for the greater good.

Discussion Questions:

- What parts of this message do you feel like you really needed to hear?
- How does understanding the gospel help us cultivate humility and an accurate view of ourselves?
- In what ways can pride hinder team success, both in sports and in the church?
- How does renewing our minds help us think of ourselves less, rather than thinking less of ourselves?
- Why is valuing the local church an important aspect of growing in maturity and having a renewed mind?
- What does it mean for us to be individual members of one body in Christ, and how does that affect our relationships with others in the church?
- How can we move beyond viewing church as merely an event that we attend, and instead see it as a community that we belong to?
